## **Course Description:**

This course is designed to provide qualifying students with the most advanced challenge to their musical ability. As inquiring learners and thinkers, students will explore different cultures, techniques and styles through music study and performance. This balanced approach to music education will enable students to become open-minded, knowledgeable, caring individuals and musicians. Public performances, parades, festivals and some out-of-school practices are part of the expectations of this class. These events will help the students learn to take risks as musicians and leaders. Principled practice and reflection on every performance will also be expected. Extra time spent on pep band and solo and ensemble work will be considered when determining grades. Credit for this course is also shared with the marching band.

## **Course Expectations:**

It is expected that every student will:

- Be present and on time for class, rehearsals and performances.
- Be prepared for class with instrument, equipment, pencil and music.
- Contribute to the overall progress of the ensemble by putting forth a focused effort.
- Follow all uniform, instrument, and equipment requirements.
- Show proper respect and care for uniforms, instrument, band room, sheet music and other people.
- Contact the director *as soon as possible* in the event of an emergency such as a death in the family or severe illness of the student. An email or note from the student's parent or guardian **will be required.**
- Inform the director of any other conflicts within two weeks of the event. Excusals will be granted based on director digression.
- As a yearlong course, students are to remain in the course for the school year, unless otherwise directed by the director.
- Follow all school rules and policies as specified in the *Owosso Public Schools Code of Student Conduct* at all events.

## **Grading**

Student's Grades will be calculated based on the following:

- Each performance 100 points
- Daily Grade 100 points
- General Playing Grade 100 points
- Outside of school rehearsals 40 points
- Playing test 100 points
- Written Test 50 points

Each marking period will vary in determining the grade as the number of performances, rehearsals, written tests and playing tests change each marking period.
